What Is The 2011 North Carolina Environmental, Energy, Health & Safety School?

The Tenth Anniversary *2011 North Carolina Environmental, Energy, Health & Safety (EEHS) School* is a unique forum for environmental, energy, health and safety professionals to obtain individualized information about the latest issues affecting their businesses in North Carolina.

The school will offer seven sessions addressing current issues in air quality, water quality, solid and hazardous waste, occupational safety and health, energy, and sustainability. Within each session, there will be three concurrent tracks with courses ranging from very basic topics for those just starting out to advanced topics for the more experienced attendee.

In addition to the concurrent classroom courses, the school will begin with a “Legislators’ Forum” on Monday, August 22. This general session will feature presentations by key members of the North Carolina General Assembly on newly enacted changes to North Carolina’s environmental, energy and safety laws. The school will close on Tuesday, August 23 with a luncheon featuring a keynote speaker.

The school schedule allows attendees ample time to visit the Exhibition Hall. Morning and afternoon breaks, buffet lunch, continental breakfast and the first night reception will all be held in the Exhibition Hall. To encourage attendees to remain in the Exhibition Hall, prizes will also be awarded periodically with the requirement that attendees must be present in the Exhibition Hall to claim the prize.

Location

The 2011 EEHS School will be held at the McKimmon Conference and Training Center in Raleigh, North Carolina on Monday and Tuesday, August 22 - 23, 2011. The McKimmon Conference & Training Center is a spacious and well-appointed facility that hosts many of the region's most popular educational and industrial events. It is centrally located on the NC State University campus at 1101 Gorman Street.

Booth Information

All booths are 8' x 10' and include an 8 foot skirted table and two chairs. Electrical hookups, piping and draping, and wireless internet connection are also included.

Booth Rates

The exhibit rate remains \$500 per booth. Exhibitors from the 2010 EHS School have the opportunity to reserve their exhibit space before new exhibitors are accepted. Exhibitor Applications will be accepted **beginning June 15, 2011**. The deadline for renewal of all exhibit space is **June 30, 2011**. New exhibitors will be accepted from July 1 to July 31, 2011. Specific booth locations within the Exhibition Hall will depend on the total number of exhibitors accepted and will be allocated after August 1, 2011 in the order that MCIC receives the **paid application**.

The exhibitor fee includes attendance by two people representing your organization in your booth and at all social events. Additional personnel from your organization are welcome at all social events, but they must register separately and pay a guest fee of \$75 per person. Exhibitors wishing to attend any of the school courses are required to register separately as students and pay the standard tuition.
